Message from Fay Jones AM: The Welsh Government have confirmed they have now reached an agreement with the major supermarkets and they now can offer an online delivery service in Wales, for those who have been classed as high risk and have been advised to self-isolate. For those in this shielded group, they will be able to access priority online delivery slots.

This is good new news for those in Brecon and Radnorshire with no other support available, although this may take a couple of days to implement. This will certainly help lessen the load for our wonderful COVID-19 community groups who are all working tirelessly.

Morrisons in Brecon are now offering a home delivery service to the elderly and vulnerable from today, within a 10 mile radius of the Brecon store.

Customers will be able to order from a generic list by calling the customer contact centre on 0345 611 6111 selecting option 5. Orders will be picked in store and delivered free to customers homes.

Customers will be able to place orders up until 4pm the day before they would like their order to be delivered, and it will then be delivered between 2pm and 5pm. Chip and pin will be the method of payment to reduce contact and to keep within the social distancing regulations. No cash will be accepted. Orders in store will initially be capped at 10 orders per day.
