Message from Kirsty Williams AM: Earlier today I participated in a digital meeting with the Police and Crime Commissioner and Chief Constable for Dyfed Powys Police Force.

I was able to bring to their attention a number of concerns that have arisen locally including ensuring those travelling to our area for recreational purposes are turned around, but also ensuring that others that need to travel are able to do so without worry.

I took 3 important points away from the meeting:

- Firstly, In the run up to and over the Bank Holiday weekend the force will be out and about enforcing the essential travel only rules. Police will be stopping people and issuing fines to those who do not have a valid reason to be travelling. The message from the Government and Police is clear. Stay at home, travel only if it is essential.
- Secondly if you have concerns about your own personal safety at this time the Police stand ready to help and support you. We know that at this time that there is a very real risk of increases in domestic violence and abuse. If you need help then please call the Live Fear Free helpline (available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week) on 0808 8010 800 or call 999 if you can't talk in safety, but you need help immediately.
- Finally, whilst the force is thankfully seeing a downturn in crime, there are sadly people out there who want to exploit this crisis for their own nefarious gains. Despite the ongoing crisis, the Force is continuing to provide all their usual services to communities.

Thank you to everyone in the Emergency Services who are doing all they can to look after us through this crisis.
