**[Powys Teaching Health Board](#) ...update on our Secondary Reserve List: Our main reserve list is for people in Priority Groups 1-4 but we also have a secondary reserve list for people in Priority Group 5 (people aged 65-69).** We now operate a weekly reserve list for appointments in the week ahead. Our reserve list for appointments in the week ending 13

February is currently OPEN for short notice appointments in Bronllys, Builth Wells or Newtown for people who meet the criteria. You only need to complete our form once each week. This is because we are now opening our reserve list on a weekly basis and we refresh it each week. If you meet the criteria below please use our form to let us know you are happy to be contacted for an appointment at short notice at our Mass Vaccination Centre in Bronllys, Builth Wells or Newtown. You must meet all criteria: aged between 65 and 69 AND registered with a GP in Powys AND be someone who does NOT already have a COVID-19 vaccination appointment (e.g. with your GP practice) AND be able to travel safely for a late notice appointment at a mass vaccination centre in Bronllys, Builth Wells or Newtown AND must be able to give consent for a COVID-19 vaccination. <https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/age-65-to-69/are-you-able-to-attend-a-mass-vaccination-centre-appointment-at-short-notice/>

**...from Rachel of RNID - Hear to Help "Drop Off" Hearing aid maintenance clinics.** Our clinics are at Llandridod Wells, Rock Park Spa, 2nd Monday of the month 10am-1pm and at Newtown, Plas Dolerw, Milford Rd, 4th Tuesday of every month 10am-1pm (so the next clinic will be on 23rd February). **WE ARE HOPING TO SET UP A CLINIC IN KNIGHTON OVER THE NEXT MONTH SO PLEASE WATCH OUT FOR DETAILS.** To keep staff, volunteers and NHS hearing-aid users safe, the service has introduced some changes to support sessions: **Please use the audiology postal service for batteries and repairs if your need is not urgent to reduce footfall and unnecessary travel.** Batteries normally sent out same day. Please call Rachael Beech for audiology contact numbers. *n.b.* Batteries will only be issued with hearing aid repairs and not on their own - Hearing-aids must be placed in a labelled envelope with a name, issue and contact details for return - A member of the RNID team will collect the envelope from the client, outside the venue - Clients will be asked to wear masks when handing over their aid - Clients can either wait in their vehicle or return later to pick up their hearing aids. They will not be allowed to wait inside the premises - Hearing-aids can be dropped off by friends or family on behalf of a user. In addition to the new distanced sessions, RNID continues to support NHS hearing aid users over the phone and by email.
