COVID

...from PCC/Welsh Government. Coronavirus restrictions update. Cases of the Delta variant are spreading across Wales. In the space a few weeks, cases have been confirmed in all parts of the country. We have reviewed all the evidence and will pause changes to the rules for four weeks. The delta variant is now the most dominant form of the virus in Wales. But we still have the lowest coronavirus rates and the highest vaccination rates in the UK. We will use the next four weeks to vaccinate even more people. There will be no major changes over the next 4 weeks, but we'll be making some small changes to the current rules. The number of people who can attend indoor weddings or civil partnership receptions or wakes, organised by a business will be determined by the size of the venue. We will also clarify in the rules that small grassroots music and comedy venues can operate on the same basis as other hospitality venues - and we will continue with our planned pilot events in June and July. We have already reached our target of offering all eligible adults a 1st dose ahead of schedule. But offers don't protect people – having the vaccine does. Diolch for keeping Wales safe.

*The TC realises there is a real problem with audibility for the public attending the TC meetings and this is being looked into (the June meeting was held via Zoom in part to avoid the problem as they were unable to find a solution in time).

*The TC is inviting letters/emails of support for the Dark Skies project. Again they can be sent to the Town Clerk on 07866 815622 or by email to presteigneandnortontc@outlook.com to collate and forward to Leigh Harling Bowen who is putting a lot of work into the actual application. Please note this will NOT mean less lighting generally - it is not about switching all street lights off. Please write in if the sky over Presteigne is visible to you or affects you - not just Welsh residents, residents in Stapleton etc are also encouraged to write in.

*The Town Clerk now has approval to publish draft Minutes on the TC homepage of the website as soon as practical after the meeting rather than having to wait for the next meeting - this will greatly improve the timely flow of information on TC activities to residents *[ed. we will still highlight significant items in the Community News together with a link to the Town website].*
