...from Dyfed-Powys Police about fake Amazon Rewards. Have you received one of these fake Amazon emails offering you "exclusive rewards"? Don't take the bait! The links lead to genuine-looking phishing websites that are designed to steal your Amazon password, personal and financial information! Delete!

The group will be aiming to emulate the achievements of the Welsh contingent in Rio five years ago. They won a record ten medals - four of them gold.
