My garden shed hadn't been locked (which was so stupid) and many of my treasured gardening implements, tools and biggish decorative ceramic plant pots have been stolen during the hours of darkness. Plus, several watering cans and buckets..... (Aldi's best) ! They seem such stupid things to steal; but I'm seriously irritated and miffed. So folks, *[wherever you live]* learn by my error and LOCK your shed."

...**a reminder on some of your local Recycling options** for those things that **cannot** be put in your kerbside recycling boxes - in addition to tetrapak-type drink and food cartons, and coffee cups, [the three ACE wheeled skips at the Bring Site now also accept Pringle-type crisp and hot chocolate containers i.e. cardboard tubes with metal caps](#) - No.46 Wine Bar will accept all crisp and snack packets which are recycled to benefit the Guide Dog charity (please package your packets in a roll fastened with elastic bands to minimise bulk) - all clean flexible plastic film like bread bags, carrier bags, freezer/sandwich bags etc (but NOT bubblewrap or clingfilm) can now be recycled at many large supermarkets e.g. Kington Co-Op (look for the bin on the left inside the store entrance) but check the supermarket website for details - SPAR are happy to take all your old batteries for recycling - your printer ink cartridges (but NOT laser toner cartridges) can be recycled in a collection box at The Warehouse and the Day Centre - there is a book bank and two clothes banks at the Bring Site (but please do NOT leave items in the collection chutes if the bins are full - especially books as they just get wet and are then useless). *[ed. If you know of other local recycling options please let us know so we can include that information here]*

...**Hereford Street One-Way system (trial) should be 'live' this week.** PCC says that the final element of the project to improve active travel routes within Presteigne will be completed week commencing 27 September 2021 when Hereford Street becomes one-way ... **from Sargeants.** Please be aware that with the current trial of the one-way system in Presteigne the 41 service will only service Hereford Street stops on outward bound journeys to Knighton and not on the inward bound journeys to Kington, please use the Recycle Centre bus stop.

Removing the clippings after the cut reduces the amount of nutrients going back into the soil, which if left stimulates even stronger grass growth, & inhibits the flowers. It also allows light & air to reach these perennial flowering plants helping them to spread & seeds to flourish. Orchids were found in 2 new places along the by-pass where the grass was left uncut earlier on in the year!

## **SCAM ALERT**

**...If you get an official-looking email, seeming to come from the NHS, inviting you to get a Digital Coronavirus Passport**, it's NOT the NHS, it's a scammer trying to steal your information. You WON'T be invited to get an NHS Covid Pass. You can get one here <https://gov.wales/nhs-covid-pass-prove-your-vaccination-status>. Please help us share this so others don't fall victim.

**...Beware of COVID Pass fraud!** Criminals are using the NHS COVID Pass as a way to target the public by convincing them to hand over money, financial details and personal information. The NHS App is FREE. The NHS Covid Pass is FREE. The NHS will NEVER ask for payment or any financial details.

**...Scam emails may look convincing, they can appear to be official, and can fake logos and websites, but be alert** - look at the IP address, look for poor spelling or phrasing, be especially suspicious if it doesn't address you by name - NEVER click on a link unless you KNOW the email is genuine, even to confirm you're not the person addressed, or to correct an

apparent mistake, or to unsubscribe, or to respond about a purchase or payment that you didn't make .... REPORT any suspicious email to [report@phishing.gov.uk](mailto:report@phishing.gov.uk) - then DELETE.

...**lateral flow tests (box of seven) are also available** free from the Library on a Tuesday and Wednesday, in addition to our Pharmacy and Medical Centre.

...**Powys THB Booster Reserve List.** We have extended the date on our Booster Reserve List so that even more people can sign up to help ensure no doses are wasted. The COVID vaccine booster programme is under way, and invitations are beginning to land on doormats. If you are eligible for the booster then you should expect to receive an invitation between 6-8 months after your second dose. On rare occasions we may be able to offer a short notice appointment - for example, because we need to finish an open vial at the end of a clinic. Only a small number of short notice appointments will be available, so currently we are giving priority to people whose second dose was before 7 March.
