### **SCAM ALERT**

### ...there are reports of potential doorstep crime/rogue traders operating in Presteigne

area. The most common tactics used by rogue traders committing doorstep crime include: -

- Knocking on your door and saying they have noticed a problem with your home that they
  can fix
- Saying they have leftover materials from another job that they can use at your home, such as tarmac for a drive
- Hard selling overstaying their welcome in your home or at your door until you agree to them doing the work.

Not all cold callers are rogue traders, but agreeing to have work done on your home by someone who knocks on your door could make you a victim of doorstep crime. There is

## **COVID & FLU**

...Powys Drop-In First and Second Dose COVID Vaccination Sessions. You can attend our drop-in clinics for your FIRST dose if you are you aged 12+. You can attend our drop in clinics for your SECOND dose if you are 18+ and it is more than ten weeks since your first Pfizer dose OR you are 15+ and received your first Pfizer dose more than twelve weeks ago (AZ second doses are by appointment). If you are 12 - 17 DO NOT attend if you have tested positive for COVID in the last 84 days. If you are 18+ DO NOT attend if you have tested positive for COVID in the last 28 days. ...Powys boosters. If you need a booster and are not registered with a Powys GP you can now attend any of our drop-in sessions at our Mass Vaccination Centres. You can see a list of our upcoming drop-in clinics on our website: <u>https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/drop-in-clinics/</u>. You can attend for a booster if you are aged 18+ and it is more than three months since your second dose.

... UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA). People without Covid symptoms in England now no longer need a PCR test to confirm a positive lateral flow. Those who test positive on a lateral flow but have no symptoms must still self-isolate for up to 10 days, but they can end quarantine if they receive two negative lateral flow test results, 24 hours apart, on days six and seven. The changes, which already apply in Wales, do NOT apply to people who have symptoms. They will still need to book a follow up PCR test. The change reflects the high prevalence of coronavirus in the community and the accuracy of rapid tests, UKHSA said.
