...**ACT SWIFTLY!** Swifts are on the **Red List** of species threatened with extinction & really need our help - they'll soon be back in Presteigne, having flown all the way from Africa, so now is the time to welcome them back - with a nest box. They like to breed in our eaves & gables, but they cannot use modern, renovated or insulated buildings as these exclude them. We have a few FREE nest boxes, courtesy of Radnorshire Wildlife Trust. ...**from Recycle Now.** Right now, only 17% of local authorities collect plastic bags and wrapping.
