Please note - the first part of the meeting will be the Mayor Making and speeches in the Courtroom at the Judge's Lodgings - this part of the meeting will NOT be available on Zoom but the new Mayor and Deputy will be confirmed at the start of the formal meeting in the Assembly Rooms.

...County Councillor Elections. Beverley Baynham was duly elected as the new Councillor for the Presteigne Ward and Deb Edwards as Councillor for the new Llangunllo-with-Norton Ward - congratulations Beverley and Deb! The result for Presteigne Ward was: Beverley Baynham (Independent) 527, Leon Abecasis (Liberal) 106, Richard Ship (Greens) 100. Total votes cast 733 - 43%. The result for Llangunllo-with-Norton Ward was: Deb Edwards (Independent) 359, Nigel Bufton (Liberal) 303, Paddy O'Connell (Conservative) 135. Total votes cast 797 - 59%. SCAM ALERT

...**beware of Omicron Covid text messages notifying you've been in close contact with someone and must apply for a test pack.** Asks you to pay the postage but then scammers have your bank card details and may then contact you pretending to be your bank's fraud section investigating irregular payments caused by your phone being hacked by a phishing text (which they sent of course)...you know the rest !!! They're very convincing and can spoof the bank's phone numbers. No matter how convincing, cut the call and ring your bank direct.

...**from Which - How to block nuisance calls.** The scourge of cold-calling scammers are forever doing the rounds - either interrupting our evenings or causing us anxiety so we don't even want to pick up the phone. However, there is good news, most of the major landline phone providers now offer a free service to reduce the number of nuisance calls that you receive.
