Leominster Community Solar has installed a 49kW solar array on the Bridge Street Sports Centre in Leominster. This is generating clean, green electricity for the centre. 94 people have joined the Leominster co-op and will make a healthy return on their investment. This is a first for Herefordshire as a wholly community-owned renewable energy project and one of the largest solar roofs in the county.
