ROUNDABOUTS AND VERGES.....a lady who lives near to the Kington/Walton roundabout at the end of the bypass emailed us to say that when she moved here, the roundabout had beds with bedding plants in the summer and this created a pretty approach to the town, near to where the dragon sculpture is now. However, now and last year, the Council are just mowing the grass. She asked what is happening with this, comparing it unfavourably with what happens in Kington. We followed this up with our TC and a representative from PCC and, as far as we can find out the situation is as follows:

Kington/Walton Roundabout - some Town Councillors took the initiative and sowed some beds on the roundabout and the area around the dragon with wildflower seed. PCC was notified and agreed that those areas won't be mown to allow these to grow. There may be some more seeding by the TC in the Autumn.

Countrywide roundabout - there were some heathers planted on there some years ago by the TC and also some bedding plants, but nothing has been done since and it's all now reverted to grass.

We asked PCC what their intentions are in future for the roundabouts, and they've told us that, in the absence of any specific plans by the TC or resident groups, PCC will simply maintain the roundabouts as grassed areas. PCC say however that, as done for the Kington/Walton roundabout, they are very happy to cooperate if the town wants to do something more with the roundabouts, as long as the work is agreed before hand, so they know what to leave alone.

If anybody has specific ideas and/or is interested to get involved in volunteer gardening about the town, please let us know and we'll put you in touch with the guerrilla gardening group who are very keen to recruit new members !!

On the subject of public gardening, haven't the Bowling Club (and Annie in particular) done a great job with tidying up and planting the sloping bank between the street and the bowling green fencing - it looks very attractive now. Well done !

Don't forget.....Clean-for-the-Queen volunteers meet up at the Bring Site at 10.30am this Friday.....the Street Party gets going from 1pm on Saturday.
