COMMUNITY CAFÉ AT THE LOCAL FOOD MARKET.....AN INCREDIBLE SUCCESS !!!

The aim of the Cafe was and still is to encourage the success of the markets, to provide a service to stall-holders and visitors, and to raise money for donation to local causes. The first Community Cafe was held in June 2013 and has raised to date £3576 for the following fifteen nominated organisations:-

Youth Club - Little Peoples' Playgroup - Air Ambulance - Community Support - East Radnor Day Centre - The Circle - Beavers Cubs and Scouts - Rainbows and Brownies - First Responders - Knighton and District Food Bank - St Michael's Hospice - Guides - Knighton and Presteigne Leg Club - Went's Meadow Playground Group - Presteigne Daffodil Group. The Cafe, which does not charge but asks for donations, has a group of fourteen volunteers who bake cakes and serve customers. There is an additional team of three bakers who provide us with cakes when needed. THE GOODWILL OF THE VOLUNTEERS CANNOT BE OVERESTIMATED. We use Fairtrade and organic produce when possible. In November of each year one of the above groups organises and runs the Cafe, helped by a team of the regular volunteers. We normally invite from Beavers, Cubs and Scouts, Rainbows, Brownies and Guides. This is an opportunity for that group to meet both Cafe customers and Market traders. The donation for that month is then passed on to that group. The Cafe has just pledged £169.50 as the final stage of the appeal for Presteigne's third defibrillator (info from Ann Curtis)
