DON'T THROW IT AWAY..GIVE IT AWAY TO SOMEONE WHO CAN UPCYCLE OR REUSE IT ... Presteigne Freegle is an online group for local people (living within 15 miles of Presteigne) to give away and get things <u>for free</u>. As long as whatever you are giving away or asking for is legal and ethical it can be recycled and reused through the group. The Presteigne Freegle group started life in 2006 as Presteigne Freecycle, but transferred to the UK-wide network of Freegle groups in 2012 and has since gone from strength to strength. Run entirely by local volunteers, there are now over 2500 members in the local group - all busy giving away and receiving stuff for free.

Your junk is somebody else's treasure ! If you haven't used Freegle you'd be amazed at what you can get rid of, and what you can get. The amount of stuff that is reused, rather than thrown away, due to the actions of Freegle is growing every day.

It's really easy to join Freegle and it's free. You need access to a computer and an email address. On joining the group, you'll receive easy instructions on how everything works and what to do. You can use Freegle from your computer, or download the Freegle app for your tablet or mobile.

Terry, Ian and Richard are your local group moderators and they are helpful and experienced Freeglers who will help you get started if you are new to it.
