Update from Welsh Water on the High Street Sewerage Problems - the sewers have been cleaned and cctv cameras have not revealed any repairs needed. Odour loggers are now in place to record instances and will stay in place for three weeks to try to identify a pattern and from that what might be causing the problem. East Radnor Day Centre will be launching their Home Support scheme after the AGM in the Day Centre on Monday 19th February at 7pm. Light refreshments served. This is a pilot project, funded through Powys County Council, and ERDC have been chosen to deliver the service which is a FREE service available to anyone >50 yrs old in the wider Presteigne and Knighton area, **providing 24 hour Rapid Response for emergency call-outs.** The aim of the scheme is to reduce ambulance call-outs, and limit the time people need to spend in hospital, whilst promoting independence and improved well-being. Residents can self-refer, or be referred via the Medical Centre or by other services. If you see a problem with slippery or obstructed pavements, potholes, blocked street drains/ gullies, faulty street lights etc., your first action should be to report the problem direct to PCC on their website www.powys.gov.uk but, in parallel, please advise the Town Council by email to pntc@hotmail.com so that they can follow up and monitor PCC action where necessary. Make sure to clearly state the exact location and extent of the problem and stress any risk or health & safety concerns to encourage prompt action by PCC (and do let the Town Clerk know when the problem is resolved!)

Motorists in Powys are being urged to sign up to PCC's Yellow Triangle scheme that could help emergency services find possible life-saving information about a driver in case of an accident. A

"Your Details" card will give information about next of kin, medical conditions, allergies and medications, and be kept in the glove compartment of their vehicle. The yellow triangle sticker is displayed in the bottom left hand corner inside the windscreen, out of the driver's field of view, to inform the emergency services that the information is in the glove compartment. Council house rents will rise by at least 4.5% in Powys from April the PCC cabinet has decided. PCC say that rent rises are within Welsh Government's guidelines which allow for a maximum rise of inflation - currently 3% - plus 1.5% and £2 a week. PCC Cabinet also recommended increasing council tax by 5% in the coming year - but this is still to be voted on by the full council on 22 February.
