## OTHER INFORMATION

**Supermarkets are introducing new rules for shoppers** as the coronavirus outbreak continues with changes to what you are allowed to buy and who is allowed to shop. Sainsbury's is the latest chain to say people should shop alone and children should be left at home where possible. A number of groups are lifting restrictions on what you can buy - either completely or relaxing the rules. Others are saying you can only use one trolley when shopping. See each supermarket website for latest information.

...from **DEFRA and Dog Charities**. There is no evidence of coronavirus circulating in pets or other animals in the UK and there is nothing to suggest animals may transmit the disease to humans. However, in line with the general advice on fighting coronavirus, you

should wash your hands regularly, **including before and after contact with animals**. It is also strongly recommended that, for the meantime, **you must only exercise your dog on-lead** to minimise touching by other people, or in case your dog should run off or be lost in which case your ability to search for it is severely limited.

If you are self-isolating or too unwell to walk your dog, or care for other animals, please call your Community Volunteers or Connectors.
