COUNCIL NEWS

...Powys County Council is urging people to let their voices be heard as the Welsh Government is looking for feedback on its 20mph speed limit. Whatever your views about this issue, the Council wants to know what you think should happen next. You are encouraged to give suggestions, along with your reasons, as to why a road should change from 20mph back to 30mph, or from 30mph down to 20mph, or stay at 20mph. You need to be specific about which road and which part of it you're commenting on, and give your reasons. If you have examples of incidents, that's always useful. The deadline for your comments is the end of August. Email your views now to traffic@powys.gov.uk or contact your county councillor.

As many will know, hundreds of Italian and German Prisoners of War were held in Presteigne from 1941 to around 1947 and many worked in the surrounding areas. A few stayed behind or returned to marry locally. Details of the camp, an explanation of a record of capture in North Africa, an actual letter from an Italian to his wife in Florence together with copies of official documents will be on show together with replicas of camp money and post-war documentation.
