#### **TOWN COUNCIL NEWS**

...Presteigne & Norton Town Council has recently changed its meeting dates and venues. The Council now meets on the third Monday of each month. Most meetings are held in the East Radnorshire Day Centre, apart from the last meeting of each quarter which is held in the Norton Community Hub (March, June, Sept and December). Currently most meetings start at 7pm but this is being reviewed in September 2025. Occasionally it is necessary to meet earlier - the time for each meeting is included on the agenda which is published the Tuesday before each meeting. Members of the public can attend meetings to observe or can also view the meetings online. The link to the online live stream each month is listed on the main Town Council webpage on the Presteigne & Norton website - presteigne.org.uk/town-council. So the June meeting will be 7pm next <u>Monday 16th June</u> at the Norton Hub!

So far there are well over 50 participants, so there is no shortage of fascinating and skilled artwork to see. Many of the visitors to the Presteigne Festival use the breaks between concerts to wander round our gem of a border town, calling in at studios and temporary galleries, having refreshments in the many cafes and pubs, and taking in the relaxed and friendly atmosphere. As well as established artists in all media, there are many new faces too making this a fascinating weekend both visually and aurally!
